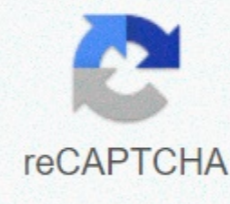

Women fire and dangerous things

A warm and cozy electric blanket is a welcome comfort in the cold of winter, but it also poses a potential fire hazard if used improperly. Never allow pets to cuddle on top, and do not stack more covers on electric blankets, because excessive heat accumulation can lead to fire. Keep your electric blanket at its lowest setting, never bend the coil, and always turn it off in the morning. We all know that emptying lint screens increases the efficiency of your dryer, but did you know that lint is also flammable? Mixing excessive heat with lint accumulation is a recipe for disaster. Clean dryer vents and exhaust pipes regularly, as well as the interior of the dryer frame, to clean lint and clogs, and reduce the risk of fire. If you own a laptop, you know how hot it can get. When you leave your computer in bed, couch, carpet or other soft, flammable surfaces, you risk limiting the flow of air through cooling vents, which can overheat your laptop and may catch fire. To avoid a fire, keep your laptop on a table or desk instead. If you've ever thought of yourself, maybe OK to use this 60-watt bulb in a 40-watt socket, you're not alone. You are, however, putting your home at risk. Installing bulbs with too high power for lights or lights is the leading cause of electric fires. Always check the maximum power of the light object and never pass the recommended rating. Prolonged wiring means a temporary response to the lack of power outlets, not a long-term solution. Here's why: Connecting a large number of wires over a considerable period of time can cause overload that leads to short circuit — which can cause fires. If you need more stores, hire a skilled electrician to install them, and you will avoid this problem completely. Americans will spend about \$200 billion this year repairing up their homes, and nearly a fifth of this cost will go toward DIY projects. If you store 9-volt batteries in your kitchen garbage drawer, you can put your home at risk. When liquid batteries roll around with other metals, such as fasteners or paper clips, the two terminals can be short-made and generate enough heat to ignite nearby flammable substances. Put a piece of electric tape on the terminal, or store the battery in their original packaging to prevent this possibility. Mice and other rodents prefer to gnaw on wires to control the length of their teeth. Over time, they can remove the sheathing, leaving the wires exposed. Regularly clean and maintain your range hood to keep your kitchen out of the way of danger. If your furniture is too close to your wood stove, it can naturally burn. Thermolythal, a chemical decomposition of a flammable object, occurs when an object (for example, a sofa) is constantly in contact with the heat source (wood stove) and eventually dries. This leads but is rarely considered the cause of structural fires that do not require a direct fire; all it takes is heat and time for ignition to occur. Candles add air and fragrance to any interior, but their soft light can grow into a much larger flame than your plan unsym supervised burning. When placed too close to other flammable items, those items may be too hot to handle—in fact, very hot, they can catch fire. Only use automatic heaters off when knocked up, and park them no less than three feet from any items that can burn, be it clothes or bedding. Every time you brown bread or bagels in the toaster, they pour crumbs that fall to the bottom of the device. In the next baking cycle, the same crumbs can heat up and catch fire, and your toaster, along with the kitchen, can, well, be toasted. If your toaster has a removable crumb tray, regularly unplug and cool the toaster, remove and empty the tray, and rinse with warm soapy water to prevent crumb accumulation. If the device does not have a shredded tray, unplug and then gently turn it over and shake it to remove most of the crumbs.
