Most people have the general idea that the presidential plane is flying in an office with all sorts of high-tech equipment. But there are two essential facts about Air Force One that the general public is not aware of. Air Force One is not technically a plane: It's simply a radio call named for any U.S. Air Force aircraft to be president of the United States. As soon as the president steps aboard the Air Force plane, that plane is called Air Force One by the crew and all air traffic controllers to avoid mixing with other planes in the area. If the president rides on an army plane, that plane is Army One, and when he boards his specialized helicopter, that ship is Marine One. Civilians usually refer to the physical plane itself on Air Force One, of course, and we are in this article too. Today, there are actually two planes that regularly fly with this designation - almost identical to boeing 747-200B jets. The aircraft themselves are designated VC-25A, with tail numbers 28000 and 29000. Both planes have the same overall structure as a conventional Boeing 747-200B and similar capabilities. They are almost as tall as a six-story building, and they're as long as the city block. Each has four General Electric CF6-80C2B1 jet engines that provide 56,700 pounds of thrust apiece. The maximum speed is between 630 and 700 miles per hour and the ceiling maximum (how high a plane can fly) is 45,100 feet. Each plane carries 53,611 gallons of fuel and weighs 833,000 pounds in a fully loaded long-distance mission. With a full tank, the plane can fly halfway around the world. Like the normal 747, these planes have three levels. But inside, the plane doesn't resemble a commercial 747s with the smallest.
