Courthouse 200 Judicial Square; Downtown Newnan In 1904, the former 75-year-old court was razed and replaced by the one that stands today, James Golucke, who designed several other courts in Georgia, was an architect, and R.D. Cole was a contractor. The cost was \$58,000. The courthouse is a perfect example of Neo-Greek Revival architecture, with sealed and formed copper cornices and farces. The dome rises more than 30 meters and has clocks on all four sides, and the bell in the tower still rings every hour. Most of the judicial functions moved to the Coweta County Justice Center in 2006, but the redevelopment plan was designed for the Court by the Citizens Committee to ensure that the court continues to be an essential part of newnan's government, community and center.
