But through my love of music, I found therapy through poetry. I've found that I have to be selfish to freak out. By which I mean not a good writer or a bad writer, but just a writer who spends the most ingested and passionate hours arranging words on pieces of paper. You can force them to brighten up, write only until you disassemble your block, until you feel it encourages you when it comes to letting your writing develop continuously. On December 5, 1976, the New York Times magazine published Joan Didion's essay Why I Write. As both personal narrative and reflection, the essay describes Didion's unique creative method and describes the reasons why she became a writer. To showcase her creative process, Didion describes the inspiration behind two of her novels, Play IT, and also created a book of common prayer.e created a space where important quotes are identified and expanded to help readers understand and ask questions about the piece. Some thoughts of meaningful quotes from Why I write when I read Why I write, pay attention to the images That Didaon writes about. Visual description is a characteristic part of Didion's style, and understanding the essay Why I Write is useful for understanding Didion's unique style and can prove useful in reading her other works. In her essay, Didion describes how she wrote two novels: Play As Simple as the Book of General Prayer (see Definitions of the Term). The primary source of inspiration for these works were images, both from her memory and from her imagination, in her head. , used to generate large amounts of peripheral energy - part of the outer field of vision; relatively minor, irrelevant or superficial aspects of the topic in question. Play as you define it - Didion's novel about Maria White, a failed actress who goes through a mental breakdown after being involved in the suicide of a close friend. As she recovers, she ponders and her affairs with many men, a frustrating childhood, her lost dream of becoming an actress in Hollywood, the abortion in which she was forced by her husband, and her hospitalized daughter. The work contains themes of emptiness and lost dreams and is considered a chronicle of the struggles of didion's generation.11 Book of Common Prayer - a 1977 novel by Didion about two women struggling with personal and political tragedy in a Central American country Why do people write? It's not a very easy question to answer when we see a world where everything is given. We don't think much about where this need comes from, and we don't always recognize how fascinating and wonderful it can really be. Joan Didion, in her essay Why I Write, explains her writing motives. She explained that the act of writing is the one that says I call myself other people. This can only be true sometimes, because there are things that read, because we need others, because we want to. We don't always intrude on others' thinking because people who read analyze what they read and draw conclusions about it. Writing is the most impressive way a person can communicate with others. There's nothing left. Words are the construction site of our world. I can express everything I feel, everything I admire; I can build my own different world with everything in it. Piece by piece, I assemble my letters to understand the meaning I try to look at in my own thinking with what I've learned over the years. On the other hand, Dision simply describes himself as an ordinary writer, a man who is most engrossed and passionate, spends arranging words on a piece of paper. She told us that she writes entirely to understand what she thinks and what she looks at with the different meaning she brings. The difference between us is that she is obviously a professional writer and that she has a different career in her life. But simply, writing is for everyone. The codes we decipher each time with our thoughts. Trying to describe and interpret the best we can with what we see. I think writing is power, and power can be good or bad, whatever the benefit we give. One can be selfish with him and hide the words away from a person who may need it, or may want to read it.
