For this reason, many of the best-known quotes for killing Mockingbird are said by Atticus. Quote: You never really understand a person until you think of things from his point of view - until you climb into his skin and walk around in it - Chapter 3 of To Kill a Mockingbird Analysis: This is probably the most famous guote from To Kill a Mockingbird. Here Atticus says that if we haven't experienced what they've been through, we shouldn't judge others. Quote: When a child asks you something, answer him for good. But don't do it production. Children are children, but they can find avoidance faster than adults, and evasion is simply muddy 'em'- Chapter 9 of To Kill a Mockingbird Analysis: A Child's Curiosity should be supplied and encouraged, not stestating. He is also trying to teach scouts to control her nature and not make her better by making others offend her. Scouts eventually learn to follow Atticus' advice. For example, she disperses lynch mobs outside the prison simply by talking to them later. Quote: Just because we were 100 years ago when we started, there's no reason why we don't. To win - Chapter 9 of To Kill a Mockingbird Analysis: Here Atticus says that even without a chance of victory, they will still fight for justice. In Atticus's view, a person must do the right thing in the face of a situation in which he cannot succeed.
