Founded in 1918, Maxwell is located on the corner of Genesee and Leroy streets in the village of Camillus. Our building was built around 1868 and used to be a church. We offer a wide range of modern materials, applications and services including: a comprehensive collection of best-selling books for printing, audio and digital formatsPopulation DVDs and streaming moviesChildren's materials, computers, history time, and creative activitiesFree computer and wi-fi accessPrint periodicalsExtensive research material online and printInformation, education and entertainment programs for adults, teens and children Library offers opportunities to engage in book clubs, preschool and puppy storytelling times , a volunteer service, and an active group of friends who support the library through regular fundraising events. Maxwell also has an excellent summer reading program for babies during teens, with the growing popularity of Wild Wednesday family nights. Almost all activities, programs and services are free (some programs have a supply fee). Maxwell Library's digital branch offers patrons download ebooks, audiobooks, movies and music. On the site, you can use computers and tablets, check the take home and meet technologically wise staff to use electronic devices.
