It is a loosely organized group of local pro-life clubs that have banded together to owe Proposal B, a 1972 abortion reform referendum that would have legalized abortion in Michigan during the first twenty weeks of pregnancy. Proposition B was defeated by a large margin, but this issue became debatable with the United States Supreme Court Roe v. Wade's decision of January 22, 1973, which made constitutional a woman's right to terminate her pregnancy and, at the same time, overturn state anti-abortion statutes. Following Roe v. Wade, the pro-life movement in Michigan, has gained traction. The National Right to Life Committee convention held in Detroit in June 1973 attracted more than 1,200 delegates. In 1974, The Voice of the Unborn was incorporated as Michigan Citizens for Life. The organization consisted of nine geographic regions, based in Grand Rapids. New local chapters appeared in almost every region of the state, but stronger support continued in the west. Through media campaigns, meetings, information packages sent to schools, colleges and the general public, newsletters and a lobbyist in Lansing, Citizens for Life informed the public and the legislature about pro-life views of abortion. Michigan Citizens for Life also pushed for a human human amendment to the Constitution of the United States. A representative of the organization is part of the National Right to Life Committee in Washington, DC, to help coordinate national and state activities and promote the goals of pro-life groups. The organization's name was changed to Right to Life of Michigan in the late 1970s. In 1985, he began participating in a national pro-life boycott of the Upjohn Company of Kalamazoo to protest the company's role in researching, developing and manufacturing medicines used to induce abortion.
