

Burning biofuels, such as corn ethanol, is better for the environment because it releases fewer greenhouse gas emissions. Now, it's time to write your essay. Stop reading. Start writing. Serious. Write your essay before looking at this sample. Once again, the professor believes that there are flaws in the writer's argument. Instead,
he says that the mass use of corn-based ethanol will hurt the economy. He elaborates on this, pointing out that the inevitable competition for corn by several consumers, including beef and dairy producers, will increase the price of corn. Another reason why the author feels that switching from traditional gasoline to corn
ethanol is a good idea is because they are greener than fossil fuels. The teacher in the listening passage has doubt that this is necessary. He suggests that as more agricultural land is created to withstand the demands for more corn, more carbon will be absorbed into the land. This means that as these emissions will still
be released to negatively affect the environment. As you can see the author and the speaker have very different opinions on the use of corn ethanol. The author here clearly defined the main idea, organized the points of support of both reading and listening and showed how they differ from each other. I know it may

However, you will notice that the structure of the models are similar to the sample tests. These templates follow the exact organization
and structure you should use on the day of the test, so don't hesitate to use them in your writing.
