The album featured top hits Hello and Run Jozi featuring K.O. His single All Eyes on Me featuring Burna Boy, Da L.E.S. and JR is one of the biggest hits of 2015. In 2015, he won the Best Collaboration award at the 2015 MTV Africa Music Awards and Afrimmas. It also remained at number one on
the iTunes chart for nine consecutive weeks. His single Baddest featuring Bern Boy, Young and Houli Khan is also a massive hit on the African music scene. It's a club banger that forces the crowd to go wild and ranks high on the iTunes Top 100 chart. He recorded a remix of the song, this time featuring some of South Africa's best female rappers. These include Rouge, Fife Cooper, Mozley and Gigi Lamaine. Yemi Alade broke onto the African music scene in 2009. She made a name for herself after winning the maiden edition of peak talent show.
Prior to winning the competition, she was a member of the girl band Noty Spices. The song that made her a force in the African music industry in 2013 is Johnny. The single, produced by Selebobo, comes from her album titled King of Queens. The song was one of the best records of 2013. It has received more than 31 million views on YouTube. Yemi Alade celebrated with many awards for the single. These include Best Female West Africa at Africana
the release of his hit single Holla At Your Body. The song was from his debut album Superstar. His album titled Ayo featured one of his greatest singles, si
than 1 million followers on Twitter. Davido – Various Davido songs rose to fame in 2011 with the release of his debut album titled Omo Baba Olowo. The song that made him a superstar was Dami Duro. On the song, he showed american-Senegalese hip-hop artist Akon. Dami Duro was so popular that the governor of Ojo state in Nigeria, Abiola Ajimobi, sang the song while delivering a speech at Ibadan University. His 2014 single Aye gained enormous popularity on the continent. The single video has received more than 27 million views on YouTube. Skelewu was another chart-topper from
Davido that went viral. The song came with a unique dance, which fans did while enjoying the song. People created a viral social media trend when they uploaded videos of themselves dancing to a song. The single peaked at number one on most music charts, including the Afribiz Top 100 chart. Davido won many awards. These include Best International Act: Africa at the 2014 BET Awards and Best Man at the 2014 MTV Africa Music including American rapper Meek Mill. He co-owns the music label HKN Music, which he owns with his
older brother Adevale Adeleke. Cassper Nyvest – Doc Shebelesa South African hip-hop artist Kassper Nyovest got his big break in music in 2013. He released the hit single Gusheshe, which catapulted him into superstar. He then released the single Doc Shebelesa, which became a party anthem across Africa. The single topped most of South Africa's charts, including the 5FM and YFM music charts. The song was featured on DSTV's Feel Every Moment campaign in 2014. Doc Shebelesa conquered the attention of American rapper Talib Kweli, which features in the remix. The song's video
has since received more than 1.3 million views on YouTube. Cassper held his first concert concert #FillUpTheDome in October 2015. He was the first South African hip-hop artist to replenish the Ticketpro Dome in Johannesburg. The venue is the largest concert venue in South Africa, with a capacity of up to 20,000 people. Southee Sol – laco Kenyan Sol appeared in the spotlight in 2006. They caught the attention of the music industry after participating in the Spotlight competition on Kenyan music. The band released two albums in 2008 and 2011, but their third album, titled Live and
Die in Afrika, conquered the hearts of music fans. The album's single titled Sura Yako was one of their most downloaded songs on iTunes. Fans created lipala dance based on the song, and videos of this dance went viral on social media. The single has received more than 2 million views on YouTube. The band won awards for this single. Mavin Records by Dorobucci Mavin Records is a Nigerian label founded by artist and producer Don Jazee. The label,
founded in 2012, is home to some of Nigeria's best musical acts, including Tiwa Savage, Korede Bello and Di'Ja. In 2014, Malin released his single titled Dorobucci.
