Thus, they are often used by companies and not by individuals. The petition may be voluntary, filed by the debtor, or involuntary, filed by creditors who meet certain requirements, added the Small Business Reorganization Act of 2019, which came into effect on February 19, 2020, a new sub-chapter to Chapter 11 aimed at facilitating bankruptcy for small businesses, which are defined as less than \$2.7 million of debt also meets other criteria, according to the U.S. Department of Justice. The Law provides for shorter deadlines for the completion of the bankruptcy process, allows greater flexibility in negotiating restructuring plans with creditors, and provides for a special trustee who works with the small commercial debtor and its creditors to facilitate the development of a consensual reorganization plan. The Coronavirus Assistance, Relief and Economic Security Act (CARES), signed by President Trump on March 27, 2020, has made a number of changes to bankruptcy laws designed to make the process more accessible to companies and individuals economically disadvantaged due to the COVID-19 epidemic. These include raising Chapter 11 Chapter 5 debt reduction to \$7,500,000, excluding federal emergency relief payments due to COVID-19 from current monthly income in Chapter 7. The changes apply to bankruptcies filed after the Medicare Act was enacted and set after one year, and, like Chapter 7, Chapter 11 requires the appointment of a trustee. However, the values oversee the debtor's assets and allow business to continue, rather than selling all assets to pay off creditors' debts. It is important to note that debt is not discharged in Chapter 11. Restructuring only changes the terms of the debt, and the company must continue to repay it through future profits.
