It is in this sense that Paul says we were watching in the kingdom of God. All we have and all we're doing now is for him. Remember, in Jesus Christ, we are delivered from the power of darkness. Satan may tempt you, but you are not under his power. He can attack and we must fight him, but we are not his slaves. He's not our boss, he has no right on us. We don't have to obey Satan – we have been delivered from his power! If you ask many Christians what Jesus did for them in the cross, they would probably answer, 'He died for my sins. As true as this statement is, it does not come close to covering all that Jesus has accomplished for my sins, but while 'for my sin was only part of what Jesus accomplished and if we limit His work to just that aspect, we will miss out on many of the amazing things He has accomplished for us. God wants us to receive and walk through all that He has done for us, not just a part of it and push the rest away! Some Christians are struggling to get free of things, having difficulty getting answers to prayers in areas of their lives, and all the time they feel like God is holding back or holding out on them. They have the attitude, 'I'm waiting for God to do this or that for me' (for example to say, 'I'm waiting for God to heal me) the problem is not that God has not done it, or that we are 'waiting' for him to do' but rather that we have not gotten the revelation of what He has done and not walked in the light of truth. John 8:32:32 And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall be delivered. There is freedom of truth. The truth of what Jesus has accomplished for us. The reality of this doesn't have the 'sunshine' of many people. We don't see how powerful truth is and how powerful the revelation of truth is powerful. We think we'll see the truth, then we'll have to sit down and wait for God to fulfill it. What it even is an area we haven't seen the truth in! It's a truth that when we come to the place of seeing the truth for what it is, and seeing what Jesus has accomplished for us, we're walking out of a lot of things we've freached with. The main reason that many people do not walk through all that God has done for us in Christ is not that God holds back, but rather that we need to learn to receive and walk through it at our end, and that is connected to see the truth of It. Sin and death are an oppressive master, and it carries with it suffering, disease, poverty, pain etc. All of the most human beings take for granted as 'normal' in life! They are not normal, they are spiritual bondage symptoms of sin. God is not a man who puts men in bondage to do sin and death. He told Adam and Eve that there should be no sin. They thought God was trying embarrassing and keeping these things in hand, they had no idea that God was trying to protect them from for themselves of cruel and sinful suffering. But Adam and Eve decided that they should know better and chose the way of sin, and every man has sinned and yielded to the bondage of sin. Romans 5:17:17 For if no one's offense fought through one, the more people who receive the abundance of grace and gift of righteousness reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ.) It was an oppressive spiritual force that controlled and led humanity. Regardless of how much we tried to get away from it, it could hold onto us and keep our asthma. You don't need to accept something from the devil that God says has no right to be in your life! Too often we tolerate and allow things to stay, things in our lives that we've released into! If I deliver myself from him, why is it still in my life? Really that's the biggest thing anyone is who's going to deal with. They think that things will 'automatically' leave them just because', and if it's not just automatically left', then maybe God doesn't want him to go. This kind of thinking is abnorable and acriptural. Since we are delivered from these things, why so many don't live free? Why are s so in our lives! We've covered this part above, in the earlier part of this article, now we need to understand this truth as well: Just because you are legally free of the devil is not allowed in our lives, it does not mean that he will not always try and take over! The devil is a rebellious – you are legally free from him, but he will always try to understand your right and push you around – he will try to bring you under his control, even if he has no right. The devil has no right to be in your life, but he will always try if you allow him is an outlaw who will try to continue his policies in your life, even if he is not entitled. The devil's rights were removed, but he is still trying to have his way in your life anyway. This is where many miss it when things go wrong, or when the devil doesn't mean the devil is just going to lie back and let you live free. That's why God has shown us what to do to make him kiteGod by saying that just because the devil is not allowed to be there, that he will now 'go', rather than there is something you need to do. 'Resist him' many people really don't know what the Bible means when he says 'resist the devil'! You refuse to conform, and you begin to get into scripture healing and speaking healing. Resisting not a passive word I will tell him again! 'Resist' Is Not a Passive Word. It's an active word – it involves actions – do something. This is where many people And they have no knowledge of what the devil is to say. Many think it means screaming, 'Devil I resist you...!' - which can be a part of it, but there's more! Offering resistance has to do with standing up against what he's trying to do in your life, actively opposite him, the way God has told us in His Word resisting someone means actively opposite of what they are trying to do! Don't allow it! You have to be actively opposed to what the devil is trying to do in your life. He has no right!, but he will try anyway! If you don't resist if I do nothing! If I just stand there and cry about being pushed, then I don't offer any resistance. I only resist when I stand my tea, by allowing the person to push me? The answer is, 'As long as they are pushing me'! Many people think that resisting the devil is a quick prayer, then forget about it. They throw up a quick prayer, then just lied back and cry because they have been pushed around! Where is the resistance from that? You resist the devil by speaking God's Word about the situation, rather than allowing what the devil is trying to make them pillaging. To resist, you must make a conscious decision in every circumstance you face whether you are prepared to accept this thing or not! If he or she has a right to stay in my life? If he is of the devil, then he has no right, then I have the right to be free from whatever it will bring into my life. Now I must oppose him and not allow him to domain. Once you have that rank, you start applying resistance to the situation, not believing, talking and standing on the Word of God – as long as resistance is necessary to change the circumstances! You have the right to free. The word is your freedom in ANY and all circumstances! As you talk it, it will work but don't stop speaking the Word! People say - How long should I resist? Well the answer is simple – as long as you have! Resistance is something you do as long as the pressure is being applied to you, and it's not simply said once or twice, 'my devil resist you' as long as the devil is pushing, you offer resistance, until you see your hang. We are the GUARTEED winners of every conflict and darkness, as long as we stand our tea, and make it the way God told us to.
