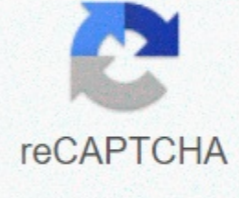




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Washington D. C was set to visit a school for eighth-grade mentor public schools students and ready to go. Students were excited, bags were packed, a lot of money was given. But on Tuesday — the day before the trip — Discovery Tours, contracted by the school district to handle the company trip, canceled. What is 511 students multiplied by \$455 each? It's paid \$232,505. Discovery Tourism patrons told Public Schools it canceled the trip because the company was unable to obtain final confirmation for the hotel room. The school district said it contacted the hotel itself to get more information. We were told by hotel management that, under advice from the hotel's legal counsel, what they could disclose to us is this: Discovery Tour was unable to meet contractual obligations, Superintendent Bill Porter wrote in a letter to parents. However, the school district said Discovery Tours told them otherwise. But the superintendent said even though the district was able to secure hotel rooms, it would not feel comfortable handing over the trip company with its students. I'm sure you're feeling angry because you read it, because we've all got the news late this afternoon, Porter wrote. We know that this is an educational experience students look forward to for years before 8th grade that is being taken from them for no apparent reason. Porter said the middle school principal will discuss the situation by bringing together all eighth graders students on Wednesday, and the school will be in session as usual. Parents leaving their children at Memorial Middle School are still very disappointed. One told us that she still wants her daughter D. The letter says: Refunds for travel are undoubtedly on everyone's mind and at the moment, we do not yet have a full explanation, but I can assure you, we will work diligently to secure compensation. Discovery Tourism News 5 released the following statement: Discovery Tours was told by the Hyatt Regency Dulles Hotel yesterday afternoon that it will not honor its contract with Discovery Tours to provide rooms on May 1 and May 2. Discovery Tours believes Hyatt's behaviour is inappropriate and inappropriate as it was paid 100% of the money invoiced by Hyatt for visiting mentor schools as of April 24, 2018. Hyatt then sent a revised bill seeking additional funding on April 27 which Discovery Tours paid by credit card on April 30. Hyatt then refused to accept that credit card payment and insisted it was entitled to keep more than \$34,000.00 of Discovery Tour funds as liquidation damages. Discovery Tours is consulting with a lawyer to determine whether litigation Be taken up to deal with this situation. At what time are the students returning from DDMS? All students are expected to be in DDMS on Monday, June 4, no later than 5:45 AM. We d. C has a very tight schedule and should be on the road immediately. All other meals (Monday dinner, Tuesday breakfast, Tuesday lunch, and Tuesday dinner) are covered by area travel costs. Students can bring extra snacks. What are the group sizes for field trips? We want to ensure that all students are well monitored and protected. For this reason, each student will be assigned a group with a total of four to six students. Each group will have a WCPSS-approved chaperone or a DDMS staff member. For most field trips, the whole bus travels together and all students will have many adult eyes. What is the itinerary for Field Trip? There are three different itineraries, but all students will all visit the same places. All students will experience the following: White House (outside); African American History and Smithsonian Museum; Lincoln, Vietnam, Korea, WWII, MLK, Lincoln, FDR, and Pentagon Memorial; and Arlington National Cemetery. What details can be shared about the hotel's expectations? When we arrive at the hotel on Monday night, all students will be given room keys and will be provided with 30-45 minutes to settle in their assigned rooms. While we cannot guarantee that boys and girls are not on the same floor, we can assure you that they will be on different sections of the floor. DDMS staff members will complete room checks and then tape students in their rooms (before waking up to the tape that is broken by the door will notify us that students left their rooms).
