Be sure to make sure that your project manager(s) sign each project you participated in. Currently dress code for young people at the fair are whites, white trousers, white top. 4-H members are also required to trade fair wear a green 4-H hat and either a green 4-H tie or a scarf. We have a variety of whites who have donated available to the 4-H county office. The available sizes are unknown, so please come and check.
