Based on the findings of the Bedford level experiment, Rowbotham published a Zetetic Astronomy brochure. Later, he expanded it in the book Earth Not a Globe, proposing that the Earth be a flat disk centered at the North Pole and bounded along its southern edge by an ice wall, Antarctica. Rowbotham further concluded that the Sun and Moon were 4,800 km above the Earth and that the cosmos was 5,000 km above the Earth. He also published a pamphlet entitled The Inconsistency of Modern Astronomy and its Opposition to the Scriptures, which argued that the Bible, alongside our senses, supported the idea that the earth was flat and immobile and that this essential truth should not be set aside for a system based solely on human conjecture. Rowbotham and scholars like William Carpenter have attracted attention by successfully using pseudoscience in public debates with leading scientists such as Alfred Russel Wallace. [9] [10] Rowbotham established a Zetetic Society in England and New York, shipping more than a thousand copies of Zetetic Astronomy. After Rowbotham's death, Lady Elizabeth Blount established a universal Zetetic Society, whose goal was the spread of knowledge related to natural cosmogony in confirmation of the Scriptures, on the basis of practical scientific research. The company published a magazine, The Earth Not a Globe Review, and remained active until the early 20th century. A flat terrestrial magazine, Earth: a Monthly Magazine of Sense and Science, was published between 1901 and 1904, under the direction of Lady Blount. [14] International Flat Earth Research Society In 1956, Samuel Shenton established the International Flat Earth Research Society, executing it as organizing secretary of his home in Dover, England. [13] [15] Given Shenton's interest in alternative science and technology, the emphasis on religious arguments was lower than that of previous society. When satellite images showed the Earth as a sphere, Shenton remarked, It's easy to see how a photograph like this could fool the untrained eye. Asked later about similar photographs taken by astronauts, he attributed the curvature to the use of wide-angle lenses, adding: a public deception and it's not fair. In 1969 Shenton persuaded Ellis Hillman, a professor at the East London Polytechnic, to become president of the Flat Earth Society; but there is little evidence of any activity on his part until after Shenton's death, when he added most of Shenton's library to the Fiction Foundation, he helped establish. Johnson inherited part of the Shenton Library from Shenton's wife, and established and became president of the International Flat Earth Research Society of America and Covenant People's Church in California. Over the next three decades, under his leadership, the Flat Earth Society grew to 3,500 members. Johnson has published numerous publications and processed all applications for membership. The most famous publication was Flat Earth News, a four-page guarterly tabloid. Johnson paid for these publications through annual membership dues costing US\$6 to US\$10 during his leadership. Johnson cites the Bible for his beliefs, and he sees scientists as pulling a hoax that would replace religion with science. The Flat Earth Society's most recent planetary model is that humanity lives on a disk, with the North Pole in its center and a 46-metre-high (150-foot-high) ice wall, Antarctica, at the outer edge. The resulting map resembles the United Nations symbol, which Johnson used as evidence of his position. [22] In this model, the Sun and Moon are each 32 miles (51 km) in diameter. Flat Earth Society recruited members through the U.S. government and all its agencies, particularly NASA. Much of the early society's literature focused on interpreting the Bible to mean that the Earth is flat, although they tried to offer scientific explanations and Decline Logo of the Flat Earth Society 2013 Eugenie Scott called the group an example of extreme biblical-literalist theology: The earth is flat because the Bible says it is flat, regardless of what science tells us. According to Charles K. Johnson, the number of members of the group increased to 3,500 under his leadership, but began to decline after a fire at his home in 1997 destroyed all the records and contacts of members of society. Johnson's wife, who helped manage the members' database, died a short time later. Johnson himself died on March 19, 2001. [25] Relaunch In 2004, Daniel Shenton (not related to Samuel)[26] Flat Earth Society, by founding it around a discussion forum on the Web. [27] This eventually led to the official relaunch of the company in October 2009.[28] and the creation of a new website, featuring a public collection of flat earth literature and a wiki, [29] In addition, the began accepting new members for the first time since 2001, with musician Thomas Dolby becoming the first to join the newly convened company. [30] In July 2017[update], more than 500 people became members. In 2013, part of the company broke away to form a new web group that also includes a forum and a wiki. In Canada, the Flat Earth Society of Canada was established on November 8, 1970 by philosopher Leo Ferrari, writer Raymond Fraser and poet Alden Nowlan; [33] and was active until 1984. [34] His archives are held at the University of New Brunswick. Describing themselves as planoterrestrialists, [36] their objectives were very different from other flat terrestrial societies. They argued that a dominant problem in the new technological age was people's willingness to accept theories about blind faith and reject evidence of their own senses. The Society's parodic intent appeared in Ferrari's writings, as it attributed everything, from gender to racial inequality on the globularist and spherical model of the Earth. Ferrari even claimed to have almost fallen from the edge of the Earth at Brimstone Head on Fogo Island. Ferrari was interviewed as an expert in the 1990 dish Earth mockumentary In Search of the Edge by Pancake Productions (a reference to the phrase as flat as a pancake). In the accompanying study guide, Ferrari came out as a globularist, a nuncio word for someone who believes the Earth is spherical. [40] The real intent of the film, which was funded in part by the Ontario Arts Council and the National Film Board of Canada, [39] was to promote critical thinking and media education of schoolchildren by trying to prove convincingly, something that everyone knew to be false. [41] Relaunching multimedia artist Kay Burns re-created the Flat Earth Society of Canada as an art project with her alter ego Iris Taylor[35] as president. Burns created an installation called Museum of the Flat Earth, which included some artifacts from the 1970 group. It was exhibited in 2016 at the Flat Earth Outpost Café in Shoal Bay, Newfoundland. [6] [7] [49] Modern flat-Earthers generally embrace some form of conspiracy theory out of the need to explain why large institutions such as governments, media, schools, scientists, and airlines all assert that the world is a sphere. They tend not to trust observations they have not made themselves, and often distrust or disagree with each other. [50] Based on speakers at the UK Flat Earth UK Convention 2018, believers in flat ground vary widely in their views. While most believers in flat ground vary widely in their views. While most believers do not believe in space and no one believes that humanity has ever traveled there, they vary considerably in their vision of the universe. [51] The solar eclipse of August 21, 2017 has resulted in numerous YouTube videos purporting to show how the details of the eclipse prove that the Earth is flat. [52] Also in 2017, the Tunisian and Arab scientific and educational world was in a scandal when a doctoral student presented a thesis declaring the Earth flat, immobile, young (only 13,500 years old) and the center of the universe. On May 3, 2018, Steven Novella analyzed the modern belief in a flat Earth, and concluded that, despite what most people think on the subject, believers are sincere in their belief that the Earth is flat, and are not just saying that for us winding up. He said: In the end, it's the basic dysfunction of flat burrows, and the modern populist rejection of expertise in general. It is a horribly simplistic view of the world that (partly out of ignorance, and partly reasoning) the real complexities of our civilization. He is ultimately lazy, childish, and forgiving, resulting in a deep level of ignorance drowning. British sceptic activist Michael Marshall attended the UK's annual flat earth uk convention on 27 and 29 2018 and noted a disagreement on several points of view of believers in a flat ground. For Marshall, one of the most revealing moments of the convention was the flat earth addiction test that was based on a checklist used to determine if someone is in a cult, without convention participants realizing the possibility of themselves being in a cult. [51] Organizations skeptical of marginal beliefs have sometimes conducted tests to demonstrate the local curvature of the Earth. One of them, led by members of the Independent Investigations Group, in the Salton Sea on June 10, 2018, also gathered supporters of a Flat Earth, and the meeting between the two groups was recorded by the National Geographic Explorer. This experiment successfully demonstrated the curvature of the Earth by disappearing over the distance of targets based on boats and ashore. [56] [57] Examples of attempts to prove flat earth Mike Hughes, a daredevil and flat-Earth conspiracy theorist, used a home-built manned rocket in an attempt to see for himself whether the Earth is flat on March 24, 2018. [585 feet) of its scrap rocket was estimated at \$20,000, and the use of a mobile home as a custom launch pad managed to climb to 572 m (1,875 feet) with Hughes inside and ended in a hard landing, but with successfully deployed parachutes. The amateur rocketeer was not seriously injured and remained firm in his flat earth beliefs. He said real evidence will come with bigger rockets. Hughes was killed in an accident on February 22, 2020 while piloting a flight of his steam rocket in a new attempt to prove that the Earth was flat. The accident was caused by an early deployment and separation of the parachute back on the vehicle. The rocket struck after falling from an altitude of several hundred feet.
