The campus consists of classrooms, studios, teaching and research laboratories, the Anderson Science Building (North Pacific Marine Lab), the William A. Egan Library, Housing, the Student Recreation Center (Charles Gamble Jr.-Donald Sperlin Shared Space), a bookstore, and office and administrative facilities. UAS also has a technical training center in the centre of Juneau, consisting of technical, construction and mechanical laboratories, a mining simulator and classroom and office space. The Juneau campus offers vocational, certificate, associate, matriculation examinations and postgraduate degrees. Sitka Sitka Campus was founded as Sitka Community College in 1962. The campus grants professional support in administrative office support, online support technology, network development, network management, healthcare information and office systems, computing technician, healthcare privacy and security, small business management, fishing technology, pre-medical care and radiological technician qualifications, and health data management coding expert; associate degrees in health data management, education and nursing (in cooperation with the University of Alaska Anchorage), apprenticeship technology and health sciences. Ketchika's Ketchikan campus is the oldest campus in southeast Alaska and was originally established as Ketchikan Community College in 1954. Now a branch campus of the University of The Southeast Alaska (UAS), the Ketchikan campus offers small class room experiences, a wide range of online courses, as well as mixed face-to-face and online classroom experiences, as well as staff and advisors. The Ketchikan campus is a leading state university system in online degree offerings, including the only interdisciplinary bachelor of liberal art and bachelor of arts, social science. Students can achieve degrees in education, business, public administration, health care, including nursing, career education, social sciences and the free arts through local and online programs. The Ketchikan Regional Maritime and Career Center, the only regional supplier of marine industry training courses and programs approved by the U.S. Coast Guard, also operates on the Ketchikan campus. UAS Ketchikan is the only campus in the state of Alaska that provides a partner in applied science in maritime transport. In addition to marine training, the campus provides a U.S. Coast Guard-approved Marine Oil Program (a qualified member of the Engine Department), welding course work, and a Certified Nurse Aide program approved by the state of Alaska.
