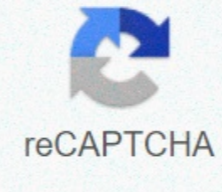

Michael Kelly knows it's time for a change, and maybe a little rest and a break. The fourth-generation Wilmingtonian and co-owner of Kelly's Logan House in Trolley Square are stepping down from their positions as Chair of McCarter and English for the first time in a 10-year time. The Wilmington law firm employs more than 400 attorneys and has footprints from southeastern Pennsylvania to central New Jersey. During Kelly's tenure, the company has more than doubled its net profit. I'm a strong believer in recirculating roles. The chairman said it was not a good thing to stay too long. We have a lot of young people. Kelly, who turns 63 in November, also wants to be around during the transition, for her own benefit and for the benefit of the company. I received a football scholarship to attend Delaware's best high school (Tower Hill) and Ivy League school. I was suddenly a poor Irish kid with two impressive diplomas. How do you want to be remembered? A good father and husband, who complied with their principles and did their best to help those in need. What are your strengths as a leader? I'm not saying I'm a good leader. But I always listened and gave my colleagues all the benefits of the doubt. Good leaders need to be inspired. But they must also create an atmosphere for excellence, integrity and honesty. What's the best piece of advice you've ever received? one of my First-class people hire first-class people. 2nd place employs third class people. Good advice. I have always tried to surround myself with the brightest bes tand. What lessons have you learned from your greatest successes and greatest failures? My biggest failure as chairman occurred when I listened to someone else recommending a business approach as usual to management. When that lead to disastrous results, I quickly learned that good management requires the ability to stay one step ahead of the competition and make it tough, popular, but called. When you're overwhelmed, distracted, or lose focus, what should you do? Look at the pictures of my family. What inspires you now? God gave me a second chance. Three years ago, I was diagnosed with incurable stage 3 gallbladder cancer. I want to use every day I leave to help those in need. What are the biggest challenges facing Delaware businesses? Get the manufacturing industry here. We are too reliant on the service industry. I want to see Delaware become a mini Silicon Valley. It can be. We also need to fix the school system as soon as possible. What's next? Two trials are coming up. Now we're going to spend more time on community activities. Mike Kelly has filed thousands of lawsuits in state and federal courts across the country. A fellow at the U.S. College of Trial Lawyers, he has brought hundreds of lawsuits to trial and filed numerous appeals, including more than 25 cases before the Delaware Supreme Court. His track record of success has built long-term relationships with numerous Fortune 100 companies that have amicably resolved the most controversial and high-stakes legal issues, including commercial and other civil disputes, shareholder lawsuits, toxic tortses, product liability, environmental, antitrust, Hatch Waxman and other intellectual property cases. Mike also often represents senior executives and other celebrities, along with clients who included the former bank chairman in the first criminal fraud trial involving a TRP-picked bank. Mike was associated with an unprecedented decision to establish a new law from 2009 to 2019, when he served as the law firm's former chairman, leading McCarter's growth and expansion into new areas and practices. Recent performance is dominant in the closely watched Re Aruba valuation case, which resulted in the first Delaware valuation decision to award a market price over a trading price. Other major wins include Cigna v. Audax, who persuaded the Chancellor's Court to strike down the terms of a generally used merger agreement on the grounds that Mike was against Delaware General Corporation Law, and Naouk, who feely v. Mike established a new basic lesson with regard to LLC governance. Mike has played a leading role in many of the most important and high stakes product liability lawsuits in the U.S., with statements including in the Serokel lawsuit, which included more than 28,000 cases, AstraZeneca's national senior management team and the national trial team. Mike won a summary ruling in the first Serokel case filed in Delaware (Hopkins v. AstraZeneca), followed by a broad public statute of limitations (Burrell et al v. AstraZeneca) decision that opened the way for settlement with the lowest litigation amount in the remaining 28,000 lawsuits. As lead trial counsel in the Lisperald product liability case, Stange v. Jansen and Johnson, Johnson and Mike secured the lowest damages to date in the Philadelphia-based lawsuit. He also defeated class-action lawsuits at Teamsters Local 307 et al v. AstraZeneca Pharmaceuticals, a decision he successfully defended in the Delaware Supreme Court and a decision that enacted new laws in connection with consumer fraud class action lawsuits. In addition to Delaware corporate law and product liability litigation, much of Mike's practices focus on Hatch Waxman and other intellectual property lawsuits, including co-counseling AstraZeneca's Nexium Hatch Waxman Law settlement with generic drug manufacturers that have caused multiple MDL antitrust class-action lawsuits. Other notable intellectual property statements are the Lanham Act trial, in which Mike not only secured a ruling in excess of \$100 million for his client, but also successfully claimed a \$12 million award in attorney fees, one of the largest fee awards in Delaware history. A popular speaker on all of his trial experience and extensive knowledge of the law, Mike appeared as a legal commentator on live state television and radio with lectures on litigation and trial strategy. Mike testified repeatedly as an expert at the trial and provided legal commentary to Newsweek, Barrons and the Wall Street Journal. He frequently contributes articles to legal publications and is a professor at the University of Virginia Law School Of Trial Advocacy. Mike has been a leader in the Delaware legal community for decades and now serving on the Delaware State Judicial Nomination Board. He also serves on the boards of numerous charities and describes his pro bono activities as his true passion. Passion.
