Reattach the opening/hose to the burner. Clean clogged gas connection holes with an open paper clip. Replace corroded or damaged burners that would emit excess gas. • Cooking surfaces, pots and pans: Clean the cooking surface with soapy water and a nylon cleaning pad.
