Nana Buluku (Nana, Nan Nan, Nana Baruku, Na Na Baraclou, Boucalou) As Nana Buluku, she is the primitive creator goddess of Benin's Fon Nation (Dahomey). As Nana Buruku, she is the first grandmother to all deities and the first human woman in the Yorubas religion. Grandma had cosmic twins Mawu and Lisa. Mawu and Lisa became a cosmic egg and a cosmic seed that easting the egg. This egg was formed from the center of ashe in the world of Ikode Orun. This egg hatched the Great Ironmole. When a orisha named Obatala formed the first human head on earth, olodumare came down from the great Adobe of the spiritual world and breathed life into it. In human form, Nana Buruku was known as Ayizan. Ayizan, (Nanan) is pictured as an ancient black grandmother, her face covered with palm heaps in honor of the palm trees she used to create shelter in the ground. In his arms, Ayizan carries a woven basket containing shell, roots and herbs. Ayizan was the first human herbalist, sacred to him is a mandrake root that resembles the human form and is a symbol of his human husband, Osanyin. With extensive herbal knowledge, he caught the attention of Orisha Osanyin, who took shape and became known as Loco. In life, Ayizan lived in a swamp swamp, he was a powerful ancestor unparalleled because of his herbs and knowledge of root magic. Sacred to him is the quicksand that surrounded his home and protected him from wildlife.
