Smith, Associate Professor of Environmental Sciences at the University of Virginia, received his Ph.D. in ecology from the University of Tennessee in 1982. The main focus of research over the past two decades has been to develop an individual theory based on community and ecosystem ecosystems As part of this work, he has served on numerous national and international panels that addressed the potential influence of human activities on the global environment. He is the author of more than 70 publications based on his research, and has been recognized as one of the most cited scientists in the field of global change research. Thomas' work took him to more than 70 countries and 6 continents. He served at the Faculty of the University of the Witwatersrand (Johannesburg, South Africa), The Australian National University (Canberra, Australia), as well as the University of Virginia (Charlottesville, VA, USA). In addition, he held research scientist positions at both oak ridge national laboratory (Oak Ridge, TN, USA) and the Institute for Applied Systems Analysis (Laxenburg, Austria). He has over 20 years of experience teaching the science of ecology to science and non-science. Robert L. Smith holds a Ph.D. in Wildlife Biology from Cornell University. He is professor emeritus of ecology at the University of West Virginia. He has spent more than 30 years teaching Ecology and conducting field research around the world. His teaching responsibilities mainly involved undergraduate courses in general ecology and postgraduate courses in population ecology and wildlife management. His research included problems related to forest fire in southern West Virginia, vegetation development and succession in abandoned and reclaimed surface mines, the relationship between forest vegetation structure and the forest bird community, and forest habitat assessment procedures, and habitat assessment procedures based on vegetation structure. Smith served as a consultant on congressional committees, workshops on environmental education and energy and environmental problems, the U.S. Department of the Interior's National Landmarks program, National Research Council Task Forces on wildlife and fisheries issues, and ecological classification systems for implementing environmental quality assessment procedures.
