Mainly because the server is willing to fall 15 minutes after going out, and also because I'm free to play players now. But I've done a lot of research and collected the best things I could find in a quick little video. This video will be divided into 3 parts, the first of us over where you xp, the second part will be about lucky eggs, and the third part will have different tips on what to do and how to go about fast leveling. Catching Pokémon, your main task should be done on Pokemon GO! Getting Pokémon 100 XP Evolution Pokémon 500 XP acquires a new species of Pokémon 500 XP while catching your Pokemon, it should be noted that depending on how well you throw the ball, you may or may not get an exp bonus. For curveballs, you'll get an extra 10 XP, and arguably easier than going for another type of catch, which makes you throw the ball inside the shrinking loop. The smaller the ring, and the more exp you get depending on where the ball lands. There are 3 levels, good, great, and excellent throws, giving exp. 10 boost bonuses for good, 50 for great, and 100 for excellent. What you may not have noticed is that some Pokestops are better than others. Larger ones make twice as much exp as natural ones, and typically gives about twice as many items as well, so keep an eye out for them! And finally, before we get back to the next part of the video, we're talking about gyms, and how much you can get from there! Firstly it's about fighting the Allies, or pitting your Pokemon against a stadium your team owns. The amount of XP per failed pokemon depends on the strength of the fight, or the CP of the ally. If it has a lower CP way you only get 15XP, if it's only a little less you'll get 30 CP. Each CP value is higher than your own and you have 50XP. Each Pokemon enemy you fight will grant you 100XP, and clearing out the entire club will give you an additional 50XP allowance. Next we talk about lucky eggs, when to use them, how to get them, and other tips. In addition to buying them in store for 80 coins each (less in bulk) you will get a free one at level 9,10, and 15, and 2 more in level 20. So as you can see, they are very rare and very limited unless they are going to buy them, so use them wisely. The most common thing to do before using a lucky egg is to collect as many pokemon first evolution as you can. Pidgey is a favorite for the most common and cheapest to evolve. Herz and They're good, too. It is said that you can evolve about 70 of them at the time from a lucky egg. Whether you want to grind that hard or not before using your first level 9 is completely up to you. One important thing to note, is that while it's not normally efficient to evolve Pidgeotto into Pidgot, if you've ever had Pidgeot before, you'll get another 500xp for the new Pokemon bonus. It's still not as good as just evolving Pidgeys, given the cost of candy, but if you want it on your Pokedex, or just get into it, and get over 70 evolutions through now, it would be a good time to do it. Another thing is to try and time your eggs from spawning and being next to Pokestop when you activate your lucky eggs. Now on the final section, where we talk about basic guidance that relates to leveling. Because of xp and the efficiency of using pokeball, it's actually best to get Pokemon unevolved rather than the already evolved ones, unless you really want it, or need it for your pokedex. It's harder to get Pokemon evolved, and the amount of pokeballs you need will normally be higher. The same goes rather willing to take Pokemon with lower CP, catching the first form of Pokemon which is 3 forms, and avoiding pokemon that does not evolve. A few other things about the evolution and leveling of your pokemon. It costs candy to level up your pokemon, so absolutely it doesn't do it unless it's in that ultimate evolution, and you know you'll keep it for a very long time. Normally you shouldn't be leveling any Pokemon before you level 20, as your base CP keeps going up while you level but arrives near that hat around this time. If you get two of a pair of syncs, their sync moves will become more powerful. When using sync motion, pay attention to the elemental weaknesses of your enemies, and save your strongest attacks for the most health goals. Only certain Pokémon can evolve in the Pokemon Masters. To evolve Pokemon for the first time: Get sync pairs to level 30. Buy Five Evolution Shards. To evolve Pokemon for the second time: Get sync pairs to level 45.Buy five evolution crystals. Once you've met the above requirements, a new battle will evolve available that you must win to complete. Be sure to go on ready, because if you fail, you should buy another five evolution shards or crystals to try again. Some Pokemon also have mega evolution available as a sync move that awards temporary rewards in battle. Complete season 10 and Interlude 1 to open multiplayer mode in Pokemon Masters. After completing Chapter 2, you can link your Nintendo account to get free gems. Gems.
