Home Philosophical Ethics Of The Alligator River Story. Home Philosophical Ethics Of The Alligator River Story. Earlier today I gave my students a famous version of the story below. This story is an example of a moral/ethical dilemma. THE STORY OF THE RIVER ALLIGATOR There lived a woman named Abigail who was in love with a man named Gregory. Gregory lives by the river. Abigail lives on the beach opposite the same river. The river that separates the two lovers is rocking with dangerous alligators. Abigail wants to cross the river to be with Gregory. Unfortunately, the bridge was washed away by major flooding in the previous week. So he went to ask Sinbad, the river boat captain, to take him across. He says he would be happy if he would agree to go to work with him before cruising. He immediately refused and went to a friend named Ivan to explain his fate. Ivan doesn't want to be involved at all in the circumstances. Abigail feels the only alternative is to accept Sinbad's terms. Sinbad fulfilled his promise to Abigail and delivered it to Gregory's arm. When Abigail told Gregory about his amorous escapade to cross the river, Gregory threw aside him with dysdain. Heartache and refuse, Abigail turns to Slug with his story woe. Slug, feeling compassionate for Abigail, sought Gregory and sharply beat him. Abigail was happy at the sight Gregory got due. As the sun sets on the horizon, people hear Abigail laughing at Gregory. This is what we do with him: Students read silent stories. Then I read the story aloud and sketch the diagram of the plot on the board. After reading, I compared students and asked them to base five characters in the story starting with the one they considered the most offensive and ended up with which they found the most morally repulsive. I ask them to briefly note the reasons why they have ranked them in the order. Then I put two pairs together to work in a group of four. At this point, we have three groups. They deliver their original orders in the group but they can rearrange them so that each member of the group is happy. Finally, we sat in partial circles and all classes had to agree on one, a definite order. 6 install >>> 3 class group 4 >>> Before the discussion started, I put some functional language on the board that I asked students to use as much as possible: I thought/believe/assume /conclude In my view/opinion From my point of view/view As I saw on one side /vice versa After saying that Some observations I - ranked from the most scandalous to the most encouraging; We were running out of time (after 45 minutes) so I had to wind up the activity by making some final decisions. However, this ultimately appeals some who haven't fully agreed to the group's choice (You see? I tell you that is the worst of them all!) Ss doesn't use many languages working. I had to take advantage of the board demonstration a few times to indicate that the language should be used. Not that it helps a lot. Ss are so involved in activities at times that they also use expressions like Shut up! I added some phrases to teach them how to politely harass someone. They disagree a lot in couples/groups. Each pair/group comes with a completely different order. Students are still discussing the topic when leaving the classroom. Students who are still in their place until the last minute of lessons (not uncommon on Friday). The board is full of useful language. Ss loves activity and appears completely in the task. I love the activity and appear completely too. Update: In the following lessons, I projected the table below, which I originally created for my own purposes. Having witnessed the heated debate, I want to find a rational solution to the dilemma myself. Then it happened to me that it would be a good way to summarize a fairly challenging topic with class. Also, I feel that since the moral dilemma has no right/correct answer/solution (and this one triggers a lot of disagreement among students), it may be good to look at the same issue again while remaining in priority cold and rational. However, another heated debate arises again but it turns out that most students don't change their minds at all.
