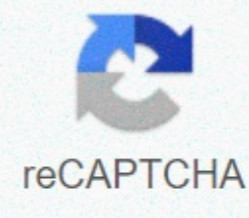

In the United States especially, manual sales are so low that most automakers struggle to achieve a single-digit take rate across all their lineups. Even Honda, a company that is known for offering fun and affordable cars can only handle about a 2.8% manual take rate in the US. As the manuals continue to die, the number of cars offered without the option of an automatic is starting to work. We race through all the cars sold in the U.S. market and only find seven models (plus their branches) that are only sold with a manual transmission without the option of an automatic one. Ford The latest Shelby GT500, which used to be sold exclusively with a manual, is now only available with a dual-clutch transmission. This leaves the Shelby GT350 and the Bullitt special edition as the last manual Mustangs left standing. This is not necessarily a bad one because the GT350 produces 526 horsepower from a 5.2-liter V8 and the Bullitt has a healthy 480 hp of a 5.0-liter V8. Ford Ford Ford The Subaru BRZ is sold with a six-speed manual or six-speed automatic, but the limited edition tS model is only offered with a manual for the 2020 model year. It is powered by a 2.0-litre boxer engine that generates 205 hp (five more than the standard car) and only 300 examples will be sold. Subaru Subaru Subaru Subaru is the only automaker that makes this list with two completely separate models. The Subaru WRX STI has never been offered (and I hope it will never be offered) with the option of an automatic transmission. It is powered by a 2.5-litre turbocharged flat-four that produces up to 341 hp in the S209 version. ITS may be aging off the market, but it has outlived new competitors such as the Ford Focus RS. Subaru Subaru Subaru The Honda Civic has an impressive manual take rate of 13.6% in the United States. This is partly because si and Type R sports models are only offered with six-speed manuals. The Si uses a 1.5-litre turbo-four that produces 205 hp, while the Type R gets a larger 2.0-liter unit producing 306 hp. Honda As with the Civic, Hyundai's sportiest Veloster N hot hatch is only offered with a six-speed manual. The four-cylinder 2.0-liter produces 245 hp (or 275 hp with the Performance package) coming out to the front wheels. This car has an asterisk attached to it because Hyundai has been seen testing a Prototype De Veloster N with a dual clutch transmission. Hyundai Hyundai Hyundai Versions Hardcore 718 Boxster and Cayman are spyder and GT4 models, which are powered by a 4.0-liter flat-six that produces 414 hp. Both are only available with a six-speed manual (for now) but a more hardcore GT4 RS could be coming with a PDK. Porsche AG Porsche AG Porsche AG Package 1LE is the most capable of tracking Camaro on the market, available with all engines from the four cylinders to the supercharged model ZL1. Chevy used to offer only 1LE cars with a six-speed manual, but strangely has decided to offer the more hardcore ZL1 1LE with the option of a 10-speed automatic.
