## South college heights pool

On May 3, 2020, as far as we know about the opening of breaking news at the 4/21 Q&A meeting, we shared encouraging news from the Larimer County Department of Health. It is possible that we could open in mid-June to early July, but more direction will be needed from the Governor's Office. Initial information suggests that we may need to implement social distancing measures such as furniture layout and spacing and marked waiting times for concessions. The proper operation of the pool and the chemical use we monitor each year should inactivate the virus in water, according to the CDC website. We retain the operations necessary to open the pool and remove the lids until the beginning of June at this time. We won't even turn on the water heater yet, so we can save on costs. The new boiler will only take two days to heat the pool so we can reverse that very quickly. As we learn more information, we will certainly share it! Originally developed in the 1960s, South College Heights lies in the heart of Fort Collins. With plenty of businesses, including shopping malls, restaurants and grocery stores, as well as numerous bike and hiking trails, this neighborhood is close to almost everything!
