

If he's still confused, keep reading. For easy crochet: When you are ready to switch colors, first decipher your last stitch. Yes, decipher, because you only need half. If you are doing a single crochet (insert a crochet, yarn and draw a loop.) Now you have two loops on the back of the knot. Congratulations, you've successfully swapped colors. (It took me a while to figure it out myself). On a cubic yard, a topsoil can weigh 1,700 pounds when dry and 2,400 pounds when moist, with an average weight of 2,000 pounds. One cubic yard is equivalent to 27 cubic feet. The amount of soil needed to fill a garden or yard is found by multiplying its length, width and depth. If there are measurements in yards, the result is in cubic yards. If the measurements are in the legs, divide the result by 27. One cubic yard of soil can cover an area of 10 feet on each side at a depth of 3 inches. Hopefully, if you're reading this, you live far from parrish, Alabama. Because if you're not, that means you're probably tired of smelling the 10 million pounds of human feces that have stuck in your local railway yard for more than two months. And to make matters worse, it's not even from residents who live in the city, because the entire population of 982 residents over 27 years of age together to produce this amount of waste. It's actually coming down pike from waste facilities in the northeastern U.S., new York and New Jersey, in large containers designated as EPIC. Local agencies have contracted a private landfill 25 miles southeast of Adamsville. Apparently, the neighboring town of Adamsville had it with waste shipments as well. However, it has been sitting in Parrish, where there are no zoning laws that have made storage illegal since then. Parrish stretches just 2 square miles, and the city's mayor, Heather Hall, says everything stinks because of the containers. This greatly reduces the quality of life, she told CNN, You can't sit on the porch. Children can't go out and play, and God helps us if it warms up and this material is still here. Hall reached out to both the Environmental Protection Agency and the Alabama Department of Environmental Management regarding materials in the city's backyard. Both agencies have told Hall that the material is not hazardous because it is technically not raw wastewater, but is instead considered a degree of bioods. Regardless of its classification, the city has compared it to dead bodies and some houses are located just 50 meters from foul-smelling boxes. There is not yet an estimated time when fecal transport will be sent to pastures. At one point, there was a 252 tractor-trailer the size of a lot of rubbish in Parrish, and that's anyone quessing what the number is now. Hall only wants the waste removed on time, and has been advised against filing another court order that can further delay the removal of the waste. The people of Parrish, Alabama, I feel for you.
