Browse interactively on the Adobe Illustrator desktop. Let's start with a quick tour of Adobe Illustrator to familiarize yourself with the desktop. In the latest version of Illustrator, you can open a file of yourself or use that file from the open document. With the file open, you'll see the Illustrator desktop. The desktop consists of an open document in the app bar, in the Tools pane on the left, and in the anchored panes, such as the Properties pane on the right. As you explore Illustrator, note that you can organize parts of this workspace so that the most frequently used items are always accessible, or perhaps to display more of the image where and edit your picture. Some tools have a small arrow in the corner, which means there are more tools that can be selected. Click and hold the Rectangle tool, for example, to display more tools that can be selected. In the lower-left corner, you'll see the View menu. Here you can select the zoom level, from 100% to 64000%, to greatly enlarge and view the image in detail. Make sure 100% is selected in this menu. If you want to zoom out on the document or slow things down, with the Zoom tool still selected, press option on your Mac or Alt in Windows and you'll see a mark - in the Zoom tool. Click a few more times to zoom out. Sometimes you'll zoom out enough so you can see everything. Another very useful method to enlarge in Illustrator is to use the View menu. Choose View > Zoom. There are many other options as you work in Illustrator. Currently, click New to create a document and open it in Illustrator. Choose View > To fit in the window. Once the new document opens in Illustrator, you can change the document settings, such as units, by clicking the Units menu in the Properties panel to the right of the document.
