1880 morgan silver dollar price

The coins were also multiplied in New Orleans, Denver, Carson City and San Francisco. About 10,508,000 coins were multiplied in 1878. Morgan Silver Dollars is one of the most popular U.S. series of coins among coin collectors. The coin is named after its designer, George T. Morgan. They were hit every year from 1878 to 1904 and were revived for a year in 1921. It was then replaced by silver dollars of peace. The coin was originally created to benefit silver mining companies when Congress passed the Bland-Allison Act, which effectively dictated the number of coins produced each month. The law artificially inflated the price of silver to satisfy mining interests. Hundreds of millions of these coins were never circulated and were kept in cloth bags containing 10 coins each. The Treasury Department then stored the bags in government vaults. In 1918, a total of 270,232,722 coins melted, but many coins remained inside the government's arches for decades. In the 1970s, the U.S. government decided to sell Collect coins. Coin experts were brought in to sort coins by value. A bidding process was used to get the highest bidders of the most valuable coins. The coins were placed in a special holder and are valued today by Morgan dollar collectors. Although mint produced Proof coins in some years, not all coins with cameo contrast are considered Proof coins. Coins that had a deep mirror-like proof finish (DMPL) were made for circulation. Many circulating coins are only worth their bullion. However, some of Morgan's dollars are very valuable.
