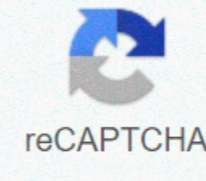

AUTHOR'S PREFACE Each chapter of this book mentions the money-making secret that has made fortunes for more than five hundred extremely wealthy men, which I have carefully analyzed over a long period of years. The secret was brought to my attention by Andrew Carnegie more than a quarter of a century ago. The edgy, lovable old Scot carelessly threw it into my mind when I was just a boy. Then he sat back in his chair with a cheerful wink and looked closely to see if I had brains enough to understand the full meaning of what he had told me. When he saw that I had understood the idea, he asked if I would be willing to spend twenty years or more preparing to bring it into the world, to men and women who could go through life without the secret as failures. I said I would, and with The Cooperation of Mr Carnegie, I kept my promise. This book contains the secret after being put to the test by thousands of people in almost every life. It was Mr. Carnegie's idea that the magic formula that gave him a magical fortune should be placed within reach of people who don't have time to study how men make money, and it was his hope that I could test and demonstrate the solidity of the formula through the experience of men and women in every vocation.
