Last reviewed and updated: June 03, Update 2020: The 12/3/2020 Constitution, the courts of the Virginia Supreme Court, and the inherent powers of the Virginia Supreme Court will unanimously extend the Judicial Emergency Declaration until January 3, 2021, and the 13th Order to extend the Declaration of Judicial Emergency in response to the November 9, 2020 (13th Order) continues to apply to the Federal Court in the future. The order applies from December 14, 2020 to January 3, 2021. The Judicial Emergency Declaration is a Va. As provided in Code § 17.1-330 (E), it may be extended for an additional period of time. It is an order too. See Judicial Emergency Order. All driver's licenses will be mailed until further notice. Only parties and witnesses are allowed in court, while the number of people allowed in court is limited. If you are sick or currently experiencing symptoms such as shortness of breath, cough, or fever, or if you are exposed to someone diagnosed with coronavirus, please contact the Office of Points to reschedule the hearing. The court is conducting hearings over the phone and/or video conference. To request a remote hearing, submit a motion to the clerk's office.
