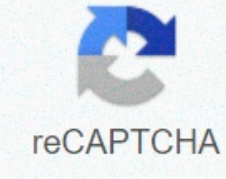

Your patience and understanding as we have worked through many factors in developing a plan to welcome back your children is highly regarded. We will start on-site and remote learning on Monday, September 14th. Our students will receive live education while at school. In their distance learning days, students will follow their lesson schedules and will receive asynchronous instruction through video, rotation stations, or inverted classes, as well as other self-developing training activities, online assignments or mini-lessons. All students will follow their schedules into virtual environments and will connect with their classes for live or synchronized learning. We will send a more detailed calendar, which will include an ABCD day rotation schedule for the first few months of schooling. This calendar will be useful for understanding when physical education, scientific labs or any other classes that meet through the day will pass through a hybrid model. Procedural changes and other informational arrivals and layoffs arrival buses will unload on the back of the driveway at 7:35. Families will fall in the front loop at 7:35 a.m. school staff will send an unloading of students who will enter through the main entrance. The student lot and entrance remain the same; students can enter the building at 7:35 a.m. Dismissal Even numbers will dismiss at 2:15 bell, followed by odd numbers at 2:17. Busses will pick up in the front loop, while families will pick up in the back loop near the main gym. Arrival and layoff plans may be a change given the patterns of traffic, congestion in the corridors or for other needs that may arise. BOCES CTE Transportation Program will be provided in all BOCES locations, however, BOCES notified us last week that they will not provide a full remote option. Oversight will be provided in the student common area on remote days so that students can work on their remote coursework Students are encouraged to arrive at the school during the departure bus of their BOCES Parking program passes to students with valid driver's licenses and vehicles can obtain a parking ticket during the first week of on-site classes. The form of parking pass will be distributed in cafes during all lunch periods first week at school. Lunch Periods Lunches will be served or students can bring lunch from home Students must wear masks when not eating, at lunchtime, or discarding trash tables will be spaces six feet apart with two students at the eSchool table and Schoology Our official reporting platform for classroom storage, attendance, student schedules and eSchool transcripts You have access to eSchool through the parent portal. If you haven't already, you can subscribe to the access by visiting the area's website and clicking on the eSD Parent Portal link on the right side. You will be able to subscribe to your child's online access to reports and schedules. There is also information on how to continue paper mailings if necessary. Schoology is a learning management system (LMS) that provides a secure learning network for teachers, students, parents and schools. This allows us to connect, share content, get homework, participate in discussions, get class information, and includes an online class that we will use. Schoology is available online and through any mobile device with Internet capabilities. This will be the main way of learning for your kids during their distance learning days. Lockers, locker rooms and fountains for the start of the year lockers and locker rooms will not be used. Fountains will only be available as filling stations. The Orientation Program Freshman program will take place September 10 at 7:00 p.m. through a virtual format. Originally we planned to do a virtual tour and video instead of targeting, however, with a delay in the construction project we adjusted our plans at the last minute, which is what we got very good at doing this summer! All students invited to participate in the orientation program will receive a separate letter, and Google will meet with a link. In this orientation, we will look at basic information about high school and our academic program. This will be a different orientation than in the past, however, we plan to monitor this with personally programs throughout the lunch periods during the first weeks of school. I look forward to meeting many of you on the 10th. If families would like to explore the full distance learning option to start the school year, please contact me as soon as possible if you haven't already done so. School attendance There is a direct correlation between school attendance and academic student success, as well as their growth and development at a young age. Attending school is important to me as a principal and it is important for our faculty and staff. Our school has programs and support to prevent attendance problems and need for intervention. After intervention On the spot, students can get additional support from our school staff or perhaps from external institutions. During the normal school year, attendance is a determining factor for participation in various joint school activities. It is imperative now more than ever that our students attend school, go to class, follow their schedules while on their remote days, and participate in their academic activities. We appreciate your patience and cooperation by working to plan and develop a curriculum that meets your children's needs. Despite the many obstacles we have encountered and the unforeseen challenges we have faced, I am fortunate to have been part of the process. I look forward to meeting our students when they arrive at school 14 and 15 by the beginning of the new school year. Students first watched a short video with characters from the animated film Inside Out with students revealing different feelings each character represents. The class then discussed the healthy and unhealthy ways in which people react to how they feel when students share examples of how they have coped positively with feelings of anger, sadness, or loneliness.
