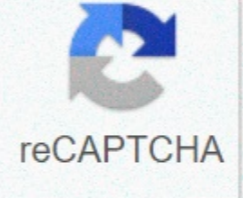

Each includes a group of references, together with Struung. This audio is a horrible way to release- there's no real video. There'll be a combination for the better one. There's not a big deal to convert the video to MP3, but it's a pain to cut them into their constituent pieces. If anyone did this, I would gladly pay something for them. Mahler 5th Sympheni: Seven Trumpet Elite: As the title suggests, it's seven people in order, the opening solo is running. I don't know who they are. They're definitely not all amazing. Mahler's Sempheno 5, with Gábor Tarkóvi: It's the closest thing to seeing a lesson with only one human. Sometimes it's good to see that not everyone already knows how to get the knee out of the opening solo. You're not alone. Tarkóvi is so kind and a pleasure to hear. Great advice.
