Thanks for the patience and understanding over the last few months as we have worked hard to determine our best workflow regarding BCLL this spring. We met through zoom, to check which other leagues decide and to adopt the Little League International guidelines, federal, state and local guidelines. The weight of making the best decisions for our players, volunteers, families and the community as a whole weighed heavily on each of us. That's why, with heavy hearts and a lot of disappointment, we are saying that we are officially canceling our BCLL Spring 2020 season. This includes all minor league divisions, Challenger and Tee Ball. I want you to know that we're destroyed. We hope that while you read this news and share with the children, you will tell them that we are broken with them. For foreigners who are not separated from the Community of the Small League, this may seem trivial in the whole emisu of things. But we know to each of us and to all of you what the Little League means and the value that lives bring you. We know that small league is an equation with spring and summer; this is a marker at the time. We will miss the crack of the bat, we will see the akid box of your first grounder, hear or watch the end of your edge of the seat game and countless other moments that can only happen on the LittleLeague pitch. We are particularly sad for our older players who are out of the Minor League. We know that the loss these children feel when they miss the final bcll season – in many ways, the place where they learned their love of the game will be even deeper than we can understand. We hope that their memories of their years throughout the minor league and especially growing up in the BCLL system will stay with them for the rest of their lives. Our first announcement to inform you all that Adelay's spring 2020 season will be sent on March 16. Since then, as previously stated, we have been on board in step with the government's data and recommendations at all levels, as well as the LLL. We would like to examine all those who have taken the time to complete and return the related to this season. There were about 140 completed studies. The results of this research were that 40% of our families were willing to continue with a certain type of season, 30% would consider moving forward based on the initial dates, and 30% chose not to participate. While it may seem that most of you really want the season, there are so many other factors that we have to consider. The first is the use of fields. As things can be known, our state and county should be in a different phase before there is access to the field. This would mean that the current case scenario would return to practice in the week of 15 June. In order to offer two weeks of training before the start of matches, that would have pushed the season into mid-August. As you know, it would be a major logistical hurdle from mid-June. The other unknown in the game is that even in the second phase we do not know what the safety recommendations would be or if it were a believer. Due to the unknown of these safety recommendations and we do not wish to extend this decision, we have been moved to make responsible, albeit difficult, decisions to cancel our regular season. We will now look at BCLL's finances and where we stand with the cancellation of the season. BCLL is an uncomfortable organization focused on enriching our children and connecting our community. Each season we manage independently with our registration fees and sponsorship, which will cover the costs that have been incurred in this particular season. During the annual period, we do not carry large cash balances nor carry negative cash balances using credit lines. Looking at this season, BCLL has dragged on a number of sinking costs. These include cargo for uniforms (which we had to send back without printing), electrical bills, park mowing, maintenance of fields, equipment, insurance,our charter, which we pay each year to operate as a Little League organization and rent a facility for our day of evaluation skills in the JMU Memorial Hall. These are all normal and routine costs that we take on every year to start a bigger season. The other cost we last added is our annual payment for the new Musco lights, which we installed in another field last year – spring 2019. Annual payments are \$15,000. We would never know or make the Covid-19 impact on our lives and community. As your board, we have a fiduciary responsibility to the teliga and our community to ensure that we operate within our borders. Each of us feels personally responsible to ensure that the decision to cancel the 2020 spring season will not result in the closure of bridgewater Community Little League. this is the league halting all-dissuading spending in the third week of March. We have reviewed our finances and decided to subcommittee board board members who will focus on continuing to make the best financial decisions for our organization, while allowing the BCLL tradition to continue and live past that. We hope that each of you will consider keeping the league's application duties. The league could produce a certificate for youththat could be used as a write-off as a donation to a nonprofit organization. Weigh carefully the long-term impact that the loss of our league could have on our community. In the meantime, we are notified from the LLO 2020 registration charges cannot be applied to future seasons. When we sent our research, we hoped that would be the case, we now know that this will put our finances at risk next year and it is best that they remain separate. We know that the situation of each family is different. We know that there are families in our BCLL community that have been economically impacted by Covid-19 and we sympathize with your situation and we want to help you do what is best for your family. The deadline, which will be on 15 June 2020, will be made to delay the return again. This allows us to hand over our finances and know where we stand and what we will have to do to keep BCLL going to continue to thrive. In conclusion, please know that we are still here for each of you if you have concerns, questions or comments for us. Thank you to our families and volunteers who have sent us encouraging messages and supported the unprecedented usduring of these times. Wehope, we will continue to have your support. We appreciate each and every one of you, and we hope that at the outset it will be difficult to hear that, after a few considerations, you will be able to fully understand the gravity of the decision that was before us and why we had to come to this regrettable conclusion. We all have to do our part so that everyone is healthy and safe so that the game can continue this summer. Social distance: ■There are players, coaches, volunteers, independent contractors and spectators will practice a social distance of 1.5 metres from individuals who do not reside in their household, especially in common areas. For cases where players are engaged in sports activity, more information will be available in the field guidance section. PPE ■All managers/coaches, volunteers, accomplices, etc., will wear PPE where appropriate and possible, such as face cladding. ■Players will wear face-to-face cladding when in nearby contact areas and in places where the recommended social distance is challenging or not feasible, for example in a long time. ■ players will not wear protective medical gloves on the pitch during the game. ■ Players, especially in the younger divisions, do not need to wear a cloth hat during a game on the pitch. ■Players will be able to wear a cloth covering the pitch during the game if they are physically able to do so, under any health provider directive or individual determination of the player/parent/guardian. Dugout: (not applicable to all divisions – junior divisions will not be in the paths) ■Manegears/coaches and players will be assigned points in overtime or in the stands, so they are at least a metre apart and need to be placed behind the fence. ■Players must stay in their assigned places when on the bench or while waiting for their turn on the bat. ■Players and managers/coaches will wear a cloth that will cover while embarrassed. Limiting the visitor to the ■All viewers will follow the best practices of social distance – 2 meters away from individuals outside their household; wear cloth face covers; avoid direct contact with players/managers/coaches during the game. ■ We decide to reduce the risk of exposure to viewers with restrictions on participation only on essential volunteers and limited family members. ■Spectators will possibly bring their seat or portable chairs. ■A with any of the following conditions will not attend the practice or game until it has been evaluated by the healthcare professional and given permission to do so: •Active COVID-19 infection -Known direct contact with individual covid-19 -plague positive testing ?
