Many chapters contain too much extraneous information that make it more difficult for students to focus on the important learning objectives and key takeaways that are assets to the work. The last chapter involving organic chemistry was tacked on and appeared to be rushed to make a General Anatomy: Principles and Applications textbook. Although much of first-year chemistry is taught as a service course, Bruce and Patricia feel there is no reason that the intrinsic excitement and potential of chemistry cannot be the focal point of the text and the course. Also, to increase the readability of the material, adding in colorful pictures, diagrams, tables and examples would be wonderful: the text is rather dry at the moment, which I find disenchanting since the material is so fraught with wonder and awe. There are also formatting problems with subscripts in chemical formulas NOT appearing as subscripts, again a formatting issue. This is strikingly apparent in chapter 14, Chemical Kinetics where many operators e, superscript, etc have been replaced with blank squares.
