God in righteousness has no option but to find you guilty as a sinner by nature dead in trespasses and sins and to pass upon you the sentence of death, the forfeiture of His Holy Spirit, and alienation from the life of God.

On the first day of Pentecost He returned, not this time to be with them externally clothed with that sinless humanity that God had prepared for Him, being conceived of The Saving Life of Christ Holy Spirit in the womb of Mary but now to be in them imparting to them His own divine nature, clothing Himself with their humanity, so that they each became 'members in particular' of a new, corporate body through which Christ expressed Himself to the world of their day.

He spoke with their lips. He worked with their hands. This was the miracle of new birth, and this remains the The Saving Life of Christ heart of the gospel!
