Partial denture planning is too often determined after all the other treatment has been completed, or else is delegated to the dental technician. The reluctance of Stewart's Clinical Removal Partial Prosthodontics dentists to undertake partial denture design may be due to confusion over conflicting design philosophies or the declining amount of practical experience given by some dental schools in their curriculum.

After reading this book, I resolved to make routine use of facebow mountings of the maxillary cast, which allow the articulator's arc of rotation to be the same as the arc of rotation of the patient's mandible.

This permits subsequent, precise verification of further jaw relation records at the wax trial denture stage, if necessary. The maxillary cast is also orientated correctly to the horizontal plane which lets the dentist and technician view the maxillary trial denture in the laboratory, as it will appear in the patient's mouth.
