I was embarrassed and confused. An emotional book with elements of love, loss, growth and hope.

The family are really poor, and the father is jailed for stealing food. Besides trying to fill his father's shoes, the boy begins a long-lasting, desperate search for both the dad and *Sounder*. It feels too heavy and possibly subtle for children, but maybe for high schoolers. I don't know why I never read it in elementary school. A poignant story of an oppressed family and their hunting dog, Reviewed in the United States on February 16, It really surprised my mom and teachers that I chose it, because it was way beyond my reading level at the time, both in length and reading difficulty, but I did, and I read it all the way through.

I hope my students enjoy it as much as I did. They are referred to as the boy, his mother, his father, the teacher. Only later when I taught sixth grade reading at IS did I complete the novel. Terrible things happen, as they often do in an unjust, prejudiced world, but a hopeful optimism presides. Then, one morning, almost like a miracle, a sweet-smelling ham is cooking in the family's kitchen. A drunkard is one of the only adults who greets the boy when he is *Three Dog Tales: Old Yeller/Sounder/Savage Sam* town.

When the boy awakens one morning to a sweet-smelling ham on the table, it seems like a blessing. Patience, inner strength, honesty, and education help the boy and his family remain hopeful and resilient, and that is why they survive as well as they do.
