Of course, the shock isn't anything a good quantity of biscuits wouldn't cure. In addition to dealing with a talk buddy Joey who's even more squirrely than he is, Tom finds himself dealing with the upcoming sports day, Dogzombies practice, and his overworked teacher, Mr. There are some new wrinkles like getting a hairbrush stuck in his hair right before his performance but as usual, Tom's cheery demeanor and can-do attitude get him through the perils of school existence.

While these books are in a series there are more out in Great Britain than there are in the US they are episodic, so can be read out of order as necessary. There's a lot of Genius Ideas (Mostly) material in these-- the "fossils" the grandparents visit and Genius Ideas (Mostly) their quirkiness, Tom runs afoul Genius Ideas (Mostly) his teacher, Tom eats biscuits, Tom is embarrassed by his family.

This is a great way to get reluctant readers interested, since they don't have to struggle to understand the setting of the Genius Ideas (Mostly) or Tom's Genius Ideas (Mostly), and can concentrate on the plot.

The format of this book is very readable, with large text, a lot of white space, and hand lettered text alongside lots of doodles. Even the size is fun-- Genius Ideas (Mostly) books are not quite as tall, making them a bit more square. The bright covers make up for the black and white insides. Evil older sisters, embarrassing parents, and fun but somewhat strange grandparents will be familiar to readers, as will the teachers, who are quirky but well meaning.

If children spilled MY tea as much as they spill Mr. Fullerman's, I'd be a bit upset as well! The peek into British schools is fun-- pictures of students in uniforms, talk of sports day, lots of biscuits, and a great glossary at the back will transport students to the real life Genius Ideas

(Mostly) world that is more like Hogwarts than US schools are.

Great for fans of Skye's Wonkenstein, Peirce's Big Nate and Kowitz's The Loser List, Tom Gates is a fun friend to have on the bookshelves of readers who devour notebook novels and want a large serving of caramel wafer flavored reading!
