Now that Charlotte's a little bit older 15 months at the time of this writing she still loves the book, and has taken to finishing the sentences as we read along or recite from memory. Instead, she chooses to treat us to more animal noises and then, in a rather poignant moment, she asks us, as readers, to consider what noises we make. The age-old question of our place in the animal kingdom has now been broached.

The worry here, particularly if this is a bedtime story, is that a child might think too deeply on this question and be left tossing and turning in a bout of insomnia as they contemplate this question.

Soon your poor child will start spiralling into questions about the purpose of humanity, whether Moo Baa La La La communication rendered by humans is really that much more meaningful than that of so-called lesser creatures, and whether our treatment of animals, and livestock in particular, can be justified morally.
