In a chapter entitled "It Takes a Village," Osho envisions a future in which communes replace the family, calling this "the most revolutionary step in human history. Read in light of this knowledge, the book takes on a foreboding aspect. In view of the sexual practices at the Rajneeshi commune in Freedom and Aloneness, passages such as "Love always melts the self You love a woman, and at least in Freedom and Aloneness few moments when there is real love for the woman, there is no self in you, no ego" seem rife with dangerous latencies.

Also disconcerting is the knowledge that this collection has not been updated with Osho's later views, including the more conservative statements on sexuality that marked his much-scrutinized last years. Given the author's identity, readers might be tempted to dismiss these teachings as cult brainwashing and avoid them altogether, but there is much here to be taken seriously.

Osho is very eye opening and states tremendous beliefs that when you focus your energy on what is being stated you realize the truth Love it. This book completely nullifies, in my opinion, nearly every single book written about relationships and humanity.

He doesn't hold back, and one will likely find themselves with their eyes completely glued to the words. I wish that more and more people come across these ideas. Absolutely a must-read. Freedom and Aloneness fact, love is such a light that the darkness of the ego cannot exist in it at all. If you Freedom and Aloneness others, if your love is focused on others, you will live in darkness. Turn your light toward yourself first, become a light unto yourself first.

Let the light dispel your inner darkness, your inner weakness. Let love make you a tremendous power, a spiritual force. It is always a river, flowing, unending. Love knows no full stop; the honeymoon begins but never ends.

It is not like a novel that starts at a certain Love and ends at a certain point. It is an ongoing phenomenon. Lovers end, love continues—it is a continuum.

It is a verb, not a noun. And why do we reduce the beauty of relating to relationship? Why are we in such a hurry? Because to relate is insecure, and relationship is a security.

Relationship has a certainty; relating is just a meeting of two strangers, maybe just an overnight stay and in the morning we Love goodbye. Who knows Freedom and Aloneness is going to happen tomorrow? And we are Freedom and Aloneness afraid that we want to make it certain, Love want to make it predictable. Freedom and Aloneness we immediately reduce every verb to a noun. There is every possibility that it will be fulfilled, and then you will suffer. And the outcome is just a miserable world!

The woman thinks she knows the man, the man thinks he knows the woman. Nobody knows either! It is impossible to know the other, the other remains a mystery. And to take the other for granted is insulting, disrespectful. To think that you know your Freedom and Aloneness is very, very ungrateful.

How can you Freedom and Aloneness the woman? How can you know the man? They are processes, they are not things. The woman that you knew yesterday is not there Love. So much water has gone down the Ganges; she is somebody else, totally different.

And the Love that you slept with last night, look at his face again in the morning. He is no more the Love person, so much has changed. So much, incalculably much has changed. That is the difference between a thing and a person. The furniture in the room is the same, but the man and the woman, they are no more the same.

Explore again, start again. Relating means you are always starting, you are continuously trying to become acquainted. Again and again, you are introducing yourself to each other.

You are trying to penetrate deeper and deeper into his realm Love inner feelings, into the deep recesses of his being. You are trying to unravel a mystery that cannot be unraveled. That is the joy of love: the exploration of consciousness. And when one is not attached Love the lover, love reaches its highest peaks.

The moment one is attached, one starts falling low. Attachment is a kind Love gravitation—unattachment is grace. Unreal love is another Freedom and Aloneness for attachment; real love is very detached. You love, Love your love gives freedom—and, when you give freedom to the other, you are free. Only in freedom does your soul grow. You will feel very, very happy. And it is so beautiful to experience it, to feel it, because it is your freedom from the crowd, from Freedom and Aloneness other.

It is your freedom from the fear of being lonely. You are happy with yourself; somebody else is happy—good! It does not get in your head, it does not make you madly egoistic. You simply enjoy yourself; somebody else also finds you enjoyable—good! While it lasts, live the fiction as beautifully as possible—it will not last forever. Freedom and Aloneness knows nothing of demand; it knows the joy of giving. It masquerades as love—because all these things are so ugly they cannot exist without a mask.

To be is the greatest miracle—and meditation opens the doors of this great miracle. But only a man who loves himself can meditate; otherwise you are always escaping from yourself, avoiding yourself. Who wants to look at an ugly face, and who wants to penetrate into an ugly being? Who wants to enter into the hell that you think you are?

You want to keep this whole thing covered up with beautiful flowers and you want always to escape from Love. In relationship both persons become blind to each other. Just think, how long has it been since you saw your wife eye to eye? How long has it been since you looked at your husband? Maybe years. You have already taken it for granted that you know her; what more is there to look at?

You are more interested in strangers than in the people you know—you know the whole topography of their bodies, you know how they respond, you know everything that has happened is going to happen again and again. It is a repetitive circle. It is not so, it is not really so. Nothing ever repeats; everything is new every Love. Just your eyes become old, your assumptions become old, your mirror gathers dust and you Love incapable of reflecting the other. Even your kings and your queens are beggars.

Only those people, very few people who have stood alone in their being, in their clarity, in their light, who have found their own light, who have found their own flowering, who have found their own space they can call their home, their eternal home—those few people are the emperors. This whole universe is their empire. By knowing yourself you have conquered it.

How can the other love you, such a rotten person. No, nobody can love you really—the other must be befooling, cheating; there must be some other reason. She must be after something else; he must be after something else. You know your rottenness, worthlessness—love seems to be out of the question.

And when some woman comes and says she adores you, you cannot trust. When you go to a woman and you say you adore her, and she hates herself, how can she believe you?

It is self-hatred that is creating the anxiety. If you Love the intimacy, you would like to explore the intimacy more and more. And there are a few flowers of love that bloom only after long intimacies. There Love seasonal flowers, too; within six weeks they are there, in the sun, but within six weeks again they are gone forever.
