You can buy a 12 month licence to have the latest full version of the book available on all your devices and there is a big saving on the bookshop price. They also offer a 2 week free trial. If this is useful for teachers and learners I will do the same for other Ruslan titles. I have posted some sample pages of the new Ruslan Russian 2 on the Ruslan website. To find them, go to [www](http://www). The new fourth edition of the Ruslan Russian 2 course book is at last ready. It has taken much longer than I had expected.

Thanks to all those who helped with suggestions and ideas and with checking my rusty Russian from time to time! The new book is in full colour with new photos where necessary. The page size has been increased so that the layout is less crowded. I have made changes to the dialogues where things needed bringing up to date and I have updated many of the info There is a new listening exercise with photos about life in Moscow during the coronavirus lockdown earlier this year and instead of writing letters our characters are using texts and Whatsapp.

Many of the information texts have been re-recorded and a big thankyou to Pavel Novichkov and Maria Orlova for their help with this. Their recordings are slower and perhaps clearer than those I used before and this means that there is now a balance in the course between normal speed and slower recordings. Several teachers had asked for Ruslan Russian 3: A Communicative Russian Course.

The files will include vocabulary lists for the information texts so that learners will not have to spend so much time using a dictionary. There are also some additional comments and explanations. In the future, if any teachers have items to add to these files please send them to me.

I have simplified the original a little and added some translations so that beginner and intermediate learners will understand more easily. After a long holiday I have restarted working on a new edition of Ruslan 2 which I hope will be ready in the first half of It will be in full colour and with slightly larger pages, so should look much more interesting than the old editions.

There is a sample of part of a page in the picture. I will need some help with some of the updating. Some texts and dialogues are out of date. If any teachers would like to help with this, please let me know and I will send you an invitation to join the Ruslan Google group which I am using to get advice.

Thanks if anyone can help with this. Sean Sprague, a professional photographer in mid Wales who is learning Russian, has kindly agreed for me to post some of his Lake Baikal photos on the Ruslan website. You can find them at [www](http://www). Look for the red link. Teachers, please let me know if these would be useful for your Ruslan 3 classes.

If so I will put them in a Powerpoint presentation to make them easier to use in the classroom. All the Ruslan Russian 1 video cartoons "Better than the Simpsons!"

There are 50 minutes of high quality cartoons in 10 lessons from beginner to A1 level, with illustrated dialogues, texts, poems and songs for learners, all with or without subtitles.

There are about a dozen different voices, including artists from the Rossica Choir of Saint Petersburg. The cartoons were produced by Alexander Menshikov in Kaliningrad and follow the storyline of the Ruslan Russian 1 course. They will be useful both for learners working Ruslan Russian 3: A Communicative Russian Course and for teachers Ruslan Russian 3: A Communicative Russian Course the classroom, and particularly useful for those teachers who want to inject some fun into their lessons!

Dear Teacher colleagues, Sometimes I receive very saddening comments from learners of Russian. Here is from an email that I received the other day. Doesn't it make you weep! She skipped most of the pages. Homework was not marked most of the time. There were 20 in the class and so we were allowed just about one sentence each to read.

She made a comment to us all that we could not read very well. It does seem that she is not very interested in Most students did not re-enrol. We really cannot say much at all in Russian. This is very sad as it was very expensive". This was from a beginner. In my opinion it is probably more difficult to teach Russian to beginners than to more advanced groups, especially for native speakers who haven't had to experience the joy and the pain of learning the language themselves.

This in spite of the fact that the pay for teaching beginners groups is often less than for advanced courses! Thanks for the Facebook likes and for the nice emails that I have had about word mazes for beginners.

I have written 12 more mazes using international words, names, places and other Russian words that are likely to be familiar to beginner learners. There is a 12 page pdf available at [www](http://www). Let me know if you find any typos, the mazes haven't been tested yet. I have started teaching a small group of beginners this year and had forgotten how difficult it can be. But great fun! I don't like spending a lot of time on the alphabet, so for the first few lessons my students often find letter recognition Ruslan Russian 3: A Communicative Russian Course.

Ruslan Russian 3 is a course in advanced Russian for adults and young people who have worked with Ruslan 1 and 2 or who have completed another intermediate Russian course. Set in Siberia around Lake Baikal, the course takes learners to an advanced level in all four language skills, and gives a wide range of insights into life in Russia and Russian history and culture. This is a 10 lesson course incorporating the necessary constructions for AS and A2 level Russian and also suitable for other advanced levels of Ruslan Russian 3: A Communicative Russian Course including the International Baccalaureate.

The material is also at the Council of Europe B1 and B2 levels. While the majority of the story-line is narrative, learners are encouraged to rework the material as dialogue in the role play exercises at the end of each lesson. There is Ruslan Russian 3: A Communicative Russian Course dictionary supplied at the back of the book. Learners should use their own dictionary at this level of study.

Learners at this level should establish strategies for independent learning. This is encouraged in the structuring of many of the tasks in Ruslan 3. It will enable you to learn how to search in Russian on the internet.
